Accomplishments

- **Led a collaborative effort** involving a team of over 100 employees focused on community motivation and development, fostering a culture of engagement and sustainable development within target populations.
- **Developed and optimized inventory tracking systems** using Microsoft Excel, streamlining resource management processes and improving operational efficiency across multiple healthcare facilities.
- **Successfully spearheaded the implementation of the DHIS-2 initiative** by providing comprehensive training and hands-on exercises across 12 districts in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (KP), ensuring accurate, efficient data collection and strengthening health information systems at the district level.
- **Identified and resolved issues related to health report completeness and timeliness** across hospitals in KP, resulting in a 90% improvement in the timely and complete submission of daily, weekly, and monthly health reports, enhancing the quality of health data for decision-making.
- **Led the planning, scheduling, and resource allocation** for the training of healthcare workers in nearly all primary healthcare facilities across KP on domestic violence awareness, identification, and reporting, significantly strengthening institutional capacity to address gender-based violence.
- **Coordinated multi-sectoral partnerships** with local governments, NGOs, and international agencies to align public health initiatives with regional and national goals, promoting sustainable community health outcomes.
- **Implemented risk management strategies** to identify challenges and mitigate risks during the rollout of health programs, ensuring uninterrupted delivery of critical services in conflict-affected

and resource-constrained areas.

- **Facilitated knowledge sharing and capacity building** by conducting workshops and training sessions that empowered local health workers and stakeholders, aligning with UNDP's goal of building national capacity and promoting long-term development.
- **Ensured gender-sensitive approaches in program implementation**, integrating gender equality principles into health initiatives, in line with UNDP's emphasis on inclusivity and gender mainstreaming.
- **Monitored program impact and led data-driven evaluations**, providing strategic policy recommendations to government and UN partners for improving public health interventions and increasing program effectiveness.
- **Supported resource mobilization efforts** by contributing to proposal writing and partnership development, securing necessary funding and support to expand health initiatives and ensure sustainability.
