- **Community Engagement:** Foster strong relationships with community leaders, religious figures, and other influencers to gain support for vaccination campaigns. Address concerns or misinformation about the vaccine, aiming to reduce vaccine hesitancy.
- **Supervision:** Oversee the work of vaccination teams, ensuring they follow guidelines and reach their targets. Provide feedback and support to improve the performance of teams and individual workers.
- **Logistics:** Coordinate the distribution of vaccines, cold chain equipment, and other essential supplies to vaccination teams. Ensure that vaccines are stored correctly and that cold chain integrity is maintained.
- **Financial Management:** Oversee the budget and expenses related to vaccination campaigns at the union council level. Ensure that funds are used efficiently and transparently. Coordination with Surveillance.
- **Teams:** Work closely with polio surveillance teams to detect and respond to any new cases of polio. Support investigations and rapid response activities in the event of a polio outbreak.
- **Advocacy:** Advocate for the importance of polio eradication at the local level, encouraging stakeholders to prioritize and support these efforts.
