After bike accident Area supervisor Faheema accompanied her to Lady Reading Hospital (LRH), where she received first aid. After the initial treatment, she was advised to take 7 days of bed rest. Thereafter she visited Dr. Nasrullah at his private clinic, where he extended the recommended rest period to 21 days for a full recovery.
