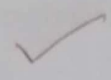

Polio spreads when a person having ^{or children} virus in his/her intestine and use open place for his waste material, then the air ~~disp~~ distributes the polio virus from that place to other place and puts the virus on food and drinking water which affects all those children which are not immunized against Polio virus.

OPV = OPV is administered through mouth. i.e. two drops of OPV to all children under 5 years at every Campaign.

IPV = It is administered at the upper site of left leg through intramuscular injection.

Ans 2.3 :

IPV (Inactivated Polio Vaccine) is much more effective for the children, as a single IPV can save a child from polio virus attack, IPV brings only the target child into safety as it protects the nervous system. While OPV protects the child as well as the environment.

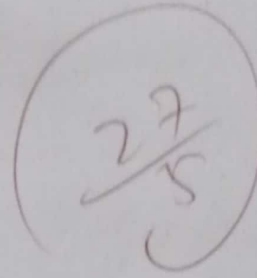
