It should not be used in routine immunization.
 • Type 2 poliovirus is an eradicated pathogen and so it is critical to have very precise counts of tOPV vaccine vials at each level of the health infrastructure.
 • Once all SIA rounds are completed, all unopened vials must be returned to the national vaccine store and no tOPV vial should remain at any level of the health. Stock reporting: . Form A should be used to report on tOPV stock levels from all administrative areas conducting tOPV SIAs. Vaccine quantities should be recorded as vials rather than doses.
The vaccine cold chain responsible should fill the form to be reviewed by the immunization programme manager.
The immunization officer responsible at the facility level should report to the district level within 2 days following completion of each SIA round.
The immunization officer responsible at the district/regional level should retrieve all tOPV vials (opened and unopened) within 5 days following the completion of each SIA round.
