Dear Naveed sb,

- In the show cause response, the UCPO has confessed to copy pasting the data without analyzing. Tallysheet is an important post campaign activity that requires the UC staff to physically go through the tallysheets of the campaign and analyze certain variables, comparing them with the form 2A, form 2 B and hence the overall submitted admin coverage. This is an important step in checking the validity of data. *The confession of not conducting the analysis and copy pasting from the already submitted administrative data clearly categorizes as false/misreporting.*
- 2. The UCPO has claimed that he was under pressure from the TDOSO for submitting the analysis, however the UCPO did not make any formal or informal complaints to his 1st and 2nd level supervisor. Had this been the case the UCPO was entitled to mention this when he was called for inquiry at the DEOC.
- 3. The claim of wife's sickness could not be substantiated and no evidence of hospitalization was presented even after officially requiring the same on email on 22nd March 2022. At the DEOC the UCPO claimed his wife was hospitalized for the last 3 days, in the explanation he mentioned her hospitalization for the last 2 weeks. Moreover when the Immunization Officer called him over the phone, asking him to submit the relevant hospital documents, the UCPO confessed of making up the story for saving himself from the situation.
- 4. The UCPO has been marked as poor and needs improvement on Reliability in his previous 2 evaluations, respectively. This incidence has further undermined his position and he cannot be relied upon for reporting transparently.

Based on the statement of the UCPO during the inquiry at the DEOC, failure to produce evidence of wife's sickness and above all confession of copy pasting the data without analyzing in his show cause notice response, the UCPO is in clear transgression of the PTPP SOPs and should be dealt with in accordance with the Performance Management and Accountability Framework policy.
