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



It is another tool to the EPI strengthen is that conduct awareness session in the community to guide the people for EPI and it is through polio staff and others.

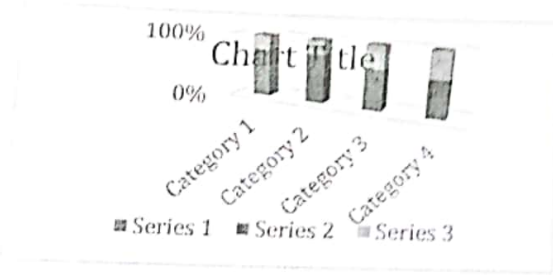
