Due to this activities we dug out those children who's signs/sentars as AFP. we dug out AFP case from the community via the help of HCPs or FLWs. Then DSO investigate that kind of children. They collected stool sample for further process or send that stool to NIH for testing of Polio virus.

Answer 3 = It is observed that local teams carried out fake vaccination during Polio campaign. A very simple way to dug out that kind of issues as field monitors attempting the following steps.

- 1) To build a strong influence network to communicate you that type of issues as witnesses.
- 2) To change one team member to dug out that type of issues for further reporting.
- 3) Guest children also played an important role to dug out that type of issues for reporting. Mostly it was seen that guest children of one area was moved into another area. which every monitor can easily understand that the concern team carried out fake vaccination, and its reporting for monitor are very easy as a medicine.
