NA children those who are not available at home during visits of vaccination team. Having record on tally sheet in Name of child, address etc.

NT (No team).  
Children can be missed when a team didn't visit a house (Missed a House) may also include children who left from vaccination.

### TVBMC

These type of children are when a team visit a house and missed vaccinating a child having no record on Tally sheet.

### Refusal children

Parents get refused to vaccinate their children. are also missed children

Note: NA and Refusal children are also missed children but NT and TVBMC are Chronic Missed children.

The difference is that there is no record of NT and TVBMC child on Tally sheet.

Still Mixed children are Present when they are
